| SUN 04 | Depart Sydney for Cancun, Mexico & arrive late afternoon of the same day. Transfer to our all-inclusive eco hotel on the Riviera Maya, the venue for our conference. D |
| MON 05 | AM Conference sessions & lunch This afternoon you'll be introduced to your first Mayan ruins when we visit the Coba Archeological Area. It's the largest network of stone causeways of the ancient Mayan world & it contains many engraved & sculpted stone slabs that document ceremonial life & important events of the Late Classic Period (AD 600–900) BLD |
| TUE 06 | AM Conference sessions & lunch The afternoon is at leisure OR visit Tulum, the 13th-century walled Mayan archaeological site overlooking the Caribbean Sea. It incorporates the clifftop watch tower; Templo de las Pinturas, with a partially restored mural & also has pyramid-shaped temples with views over the surrounding jungle. BLD |
| WED 07 | The Chichen Itza Archeological Site, is where we'll be visiting today on our full day tour. It's a world-famous complex of Mayan ruins with the massive step pyramid - known as El Castillo - dominating the ancient city, which thrived from 600AD to the 1200s. After a couple of hours exploring this site, you'll enjoy a delicious Mexican buffet lunch & there's the chance to swim in a Cenote, a natural swimming hole. BLD |
| THU 08 | AM Conference sessions & lunch The afternoon is free to relax at the resort, do a kayak or bike tour, relax by the pools or beach or go shopping in Playa del Carman. Our farewell dinner tonight will be a fun Mexican fiesta party, complete with music & dancing. BLD |

| MON 26 | Depart Sydney & arrive into Mexico City on the same day. Transfer to our hotel |
| TUE 27 | Today you'll discover the delights of Mexico City - the Zocalo, the Diego Rivera murals in the National Palace, Metropolitan Cathedral, the Federal District buildings, Chapultepec & Reforma Avenues. Lunch & free time in the historic suburb of Coyoacan. BL |
| WED 28 | Today you'll see the wonderful Teotihuacán archaeological complex, an ancient Mesoamerican city,constructed about 200CE & then visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, one of the most important Catholic pilgrimage sites in the world BL |
| THU 01 | Fly to Merida which has a rich Mayan & colonial heritage. On arrival, we'll do a walking tour of this quaint city, with its pastel-coloured buildings, old churches & main square, followed by an included dinner BD |

| SUN 04 | Leave Merida & visit Ek Balam, a Yucatec-Maya archaeological site, which was the seat of a Mayan kingdom. You can climb the largest structure, the Acropolis for a splendid view of the archaeological site. Onto the colonial town of Valladolid for a walking tour of this cute town before heading to our conference hotel. BLD |

| FRI 09 | Start your Cuban adventure flying to Havana. On arrival transfer to our hotel BD |
| SAT 10 | Our full day tour starts with Hemingway - visit his former haunts where everything is as he left it. There'll be a walking tour of Old Havana (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) to see beautiful buildings, cobblestoned squares, vintage cars & narrow lanes. There'll also be a stop at the Handicraft Market BL |
| SUN 11 | This morning you'll discover modern Havana with stops at Revolution Sq, Morro Castle for a lovely view of Havana. Visit the National Hotel & the Revolution Museum housed in the former Presidential Palace. The afternoon is at leisure B |
| MON 12 | Leave Havana today & travel to Trinidad with a stop in Cienfuegos (the pearl of the south) for a look at this colourful town before continuing to Trinidad. BLD |
| TUE 13 | Our morning tour is Trinidad, Cuba's best preserved colonial town, with the old part of Trinidad declared a UNESCO heritage. It's gorgeous with brightly colored buildings, cobblestone streets. & the main square Plaza Mayor, is surrounded by grand colonial buildings. The afternoon is free to discover this gem for yourself before dinner in a paladar BD |
| WED 14 | We pass through Valley of the Sugar Mills this morning (a series of 3 interconnected valleys) on our way to Santa Clara to visit Che Guevara's mausoleum & museum - a major figure of the Cuban Revolution. Tonight we're back in Havana BL |
| THU 15 | Our full day tour is to the western part of the island, tobacco production country. You'll visit a cigar factory to see the process of making cigars before continuing to the Vinales valley to admire the unique & picturesque rock formations & see the Mural de la Historica BL |
